Brama is a medium bodied white wine from Grenache Gris. This wine is from a parcel of 1Ha with mixed soil of limestone and clay above Felines-Minervois.

*Very limited annual production, only 2000 bottles per year*

## NOSE :

Fresh, focused tropical fruits, honeysuckle, lemon rind, and buttered almonds on the nose.

## TASTING NOTES :

Medium - bodied, racy, and pure on the palate, with a lovely, elegant texture that's lifted by the wines acidity.

## WINEMAKING :

*Vinification :*

Following our biodynamic philosophy, the process is very natural with minimal intervention. Vinified in oak barrels, no malolactic.

*Ageing :* 10 months in 600L Radoux Alliers Barrels, then 6 months in egg.

**Ageing potential :** 5 – 10 years

**Serving temperature :** 10° - 12°C
