Rose de Nymphe Émue



The « Cuisse de Nymphe » is a type of rose. It is very pale pink, almost mauve. It was brought to France at the end of XVI century from Crimea. Its name was “Rosier blanc royal”. This Rosé is a blend of Grenache noir.

IGP OC Grenache noir - 13 % vol. alcohol

NOSE :

Fresh, mineral notes balance notes of maraschino cherries, apricots, eucalyptus, and raspberry brambles.

TASTING NOTES :

Its roundness is driven by a lovely acidity. Flavors of tart fruit on the finish. This is a dry, berried wine that pairs beautifully with a plate of prosciutto and ripe summer tomatoes.

WINEMAKING :

The process respects the principles of Biodynamics, with minimal intervention.

Serving temperature : 10°C
