NOSE :

The color is deep purple. Elegant and complex, aromas of cassis and grenadine with roasted coffee beans and cherry.

TASTING NOTES :

Medium-bodied, fresh and juicy, focused and smooth palate with generous fruit. A vibrant and tense wine with a great finish.

WINEMAKING :

Vinification :

Maceration in tanks for one month with gentle pumping over and 'pigeage' (punching down). Short vinification of 3 months.

Serving temperature: 16°C

Ageing potential : 5 – 10 years
